

The House of Hope

What is the House of Hope?

The House of Hope is a 4 bedroom lodging house located in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia for men recovering from addiction. Residents of the house are committed to sobriety, supporting one another, and giving back to the local community through volunteerism. Our Lady of Guadalupe provides the house and support services as needed.

Who can apply?

Men over the age of 19 with at least 12 months of sobriety who regularly attend an addiction support group can apply to live in the House of Hope. The application is reviewed by the committee as well as current residents in the house. Stays at the House of Hope are an average of 24 months, or until independent living is achieved.

Expectations

Residents of the House of Hope are expected to contribute to the upkeep of the house and community as agreed on in the community covenant and application, avoid alcohol and drug use on and off the premises, attend support groups regularly, and engage with staff and fellow residents appropriately and with respect.
